
1 Introduction

If the system flags an error Alert the desktop resolution error, you can change your desktop resolution by following steps.





1.3.1 Windows Users

1. Please right click on the desktop.
2. Click on 'Screen resolution'.




3. The following screen will open.



4. Click on Resolution Drop down and choose a resolution supported by CWC and
Click 'Apply' and 'OK'.

5. Then login back to CWC and the error bar on top your screen should now go away.



1.3.2 MAC Users

If the system flags the desktop resolution error, you can change your desktop resolution by following steps


1. Click on the Apple logo in the upper-left corner of your display



2. Click System Preferences, then click Displays



3. Click Displays if it is not already selected



4. Select a resolution from the list of available resolutions
5. Mac OS immediately applies the new setting

1.4 Browser Zoom issue

The system can generate the error bar in case the Browser Zoom is not set to 100%. Please do the following steps to change your zoom level.

Click on the Page from Menu bar and Change the Zoom level to 100%.
