#### 1.3 Browser Issue

#### 1.3.1 Browser Version Issue

The system can flag an error Alert for two possible reasons.

- a. Browser Version
- b. Internet Explorer with Compatibility view.

#### For IE compatibility issues follow the below steps.

1.3.1.1 **Check your browser Compatibility mode** – Even when Browser version is supported, you could see the message possibly because of compatible view issue on IE.

1. To change the browser from IE8 or IE9 Compatibility View mode, Click F12 key in keyboard. Developer toolbar will get added at the bottom of the browser above the status bar or on top of the page.



2. Click on Browser Mode IE 8 or IE9 and make sure "Internet Explorer 8 Compatibility View" is **NOT** selected.
